BIATHLON RULES

The St Ives biathlon is organised by **St Ives Surf Lifesaving Club** which is a registered charity. After expenses all monies raised will go to the club to be used as agreed by the committee and trustees.

By entering the event you agree to abide to the following:

There are strict age rules

All Junior entrants must be a minimum of 12 years old on the day and no older than 16 years. Forms must be signed by a parent or legal guardian.

All open entrants must be a minimum of 17 years on the day with no upper age limit. If under 18 forms must be signed by a parent or legal guardian.

Veteran race is open to anyone 40 years on the day or older.

Super veteran race is open to anyone 50 years on the day or older.

Team event – Competitors must be a minimum of 17 years on the day with no upper age limit. Competitor 1 to run to Carbis Bay, tag their partner and Competitor 2 swim from Carbis Bay beach to St Ives.

Prizes will be awarded as follows

Junior race – First, second and third in both male and female categories Open race – First, second and third in both male and female categories, plus first local Vet race (40+) – First male and first female Super vet (50+) – First male and first female Novice race – There are no prizes but an awful lot of satisfaction!!!! Team Race – First team whether male/female or combined

To be eligible to enter as a local you must either be a member of St Ives surf lifesaving club or have primary residence within the TR26 postcode.

The organisers aim for this to be an inclusive event. However, entrants must be able to run and swim the required distance. If individuals require additional support this needs to be organised by the individual however they need to inform the organisers of the event prior to entering.

A risk assessment will be undertaken prior to the event taking place by Senior Lifeguards and the Harbour Master. If they are concerned about safety due to sea conditions they have the right to cancel the event. **Entry Fees are non-refundable.** In the event of a cancelation monies raised will be used to cover pre event expenses and any remainder will be put towards club management and future events.

Event organisers and appointed safety members of St Ives surf lifesaving club have the right to remove any individual if there are any concerns for safety. **Entry fees will not be reimbursed**

No more than 250 competitors will be allowed to enter the water for any single event. The organisers reserve the right to run multiple races together.

Pre- entries for all races will be charged at a reduced rate, as advertised.

Entries received after the pre- entry closing date (2 weeks prior to the event on 22nd June 2019) will be entered on the night and entrants will be charged the additional amount as advertised.

T-shirts are only guaranteed for pre entries. we will endeavour to have them for all but this will be on a first come first served basis & Sizes cannot be guaranteed. There are NO children sizes.

The information will only be available to members of the results team and appropriate race officials, and will not be passed to any other person or agency.
